("NOTICE OF INTENT TO WITHDRAW")

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN OF BDO GOVERNMENT SERVICES, LLC'S WITHDRAWAL OF REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS #PC-002, WITHDRAWAL OF THE NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD POSTED ON FEBRUARY 13, 2026, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT - DISASTER RECOVERY (CDBG-DR) RECONSTRUCTION, REHABILITATION, AND MHU REPLACEMENT SERVICES IN SUPPORT OF THE PEOPLE FIRST HURRICANE RECOVERY PROGRAM (the "RFP"), ISSUED ON DECEMBER 19, 2025, AND REJECTION OF ALL SOLICITATION RESPONSES SUBMITTED IN RESPONSE TO THE RFP.

BDO intends to issue a new request for proposals in support of the People First Hurricane Recovery Program.

A vendor who is aggrieved by the actions set forth in this NOTICE OF INTENT TO WITHDRAW may file a written protest to BDO GOVERNMENT SERVICES, LLC c/o Danny Permar, at GeneralContractors@pinellas-recovers.com. ***No other actions or recommendations in connection with a solicitation can be protested, including: (i) requests for quotations, negotiations, qualifications or letters of interest; (ii) rejection of some, all or parts of bids or proposals; (iii) disqualification of bidders or proposers as non-responsive or non-responsible; or (iv) recommended awards less than the mandatory bid or proposal amount. Protests failing to comply with the provisions of this section shall not be reviewed.***

A formal written protest must be filed no later than 11:59 p.m. EST on the fifth full business day after the posting of this NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL.

The formal written protest shall identify the protesting party and the RFP; include a statement of the grounds on which the protest is based; refer to the statutes, laws, ordinances or other legal authorities which the protesting party deems applicable to such grounds; and specifically request the relief to which the protesting party deems itself entitled by application of such authorities to such grounds.

A formal written protest is considered filed with BDO when BDO receives it. Accordingly, a protest is not timely filed unless it is received within the time specified above by the BDO c/o Danny Permar at GeneralContractors@pinellas-recovers.com. Failure to file a formal written protest within the time period specified shall constitute a waiver of the right to protest and result in relinquishment of all rights to protest by the bidder or proposer.
