A vendor who is aggrieved by the recommended and intended awards as set forth in this NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD may file a written protest to the director, at [GeneralContractors@pinellas-recovers.com](mailto:GeneralContractors@pinellas-recovers.com). ***No other actions or recommendations in connection with a solicitation can be protested, including: (i) requests for quotations, negotiations, qualifications or letters of interest; (ii) rejection of some, all or parts of bids or proposals; (iii) disqualification of bidders or proposers as non-responsive or non-responsible; or (iv) recommended awards less than the mandatory bid or proposal amount. Protests failing to comply with the provisions of this section shall not be reviewed.***

A formal written protest must be filed no later than 5:00 p.m. EST on the fifth full business day after the posting of the award recommendation.

The formal written protest shall identify the protesting party and the RFP; include a statement of the grounds on which the protest is based; refer to the statutes, laws, ordinances or other legal authorities which the protesting party deems applicable to such grounds; and specifically request the relief to which the protesting party deems itself entitled by application of such authorities to such grounds.

A formal written protest is considered filed with the county when the purchasing division receives it. Accordingly, a protest is not timely filed unless it is received within the time specified above by the purchasing division. Failure to file a formal written protest within the time period specified shall constitute a waiver of the right to protest and result in relinquishment of all rights to protest by the bidder or proposer.
